**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
NEWVILLE BOROUGH, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPOINTING
PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL CODE ALLIANCE, INC. AS A THIRD-PARTY
AGENCY SELECTED TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE VARIOUS LOCAL
ORDINANCE, CODES, AND REGULATIONS AND SERVE AS A CODE
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN NEWVILLE BOROUGH**

WHEREAS, Newville Borough has elected to enact various ordinances and regulations; and

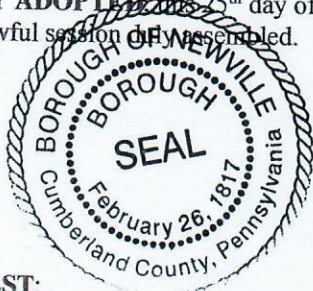
WHEREAS, Newville Borough has elected to administer and enforce various ordinances and regulations by retaining a third-party agency to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council desires to appoint Pennsylvania Municipal Code Alliance, Inc. as a third-party agency responsible for the administration and enforcement of various ordinances and regulations and to serve as a Code Enforcement Officer of Newville Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of Newville Borough as follows:

1. The Newville Borough hereby appoints Pennsylvania Municipal Code Alliance, Inc. as a third-party agency responsible for the administration and enforcement of various ordinances and regulations as requested, as adopted and as may be amended by the ordinances of this municipality and to serve as a Code Enforcement Officer in Newville Borough.
2. Any fees charged for permits or for other services related to code enforcement, shall be in accordance with a schedule of fees established by Pennsylvania Municipal Code Alliance, Inc. from time to time and provided to Newville Borough.
3. The Newville Borough may request, from time to time, that Pennsylvania Municipal Code Alliance, Inc. provide other services to Newville Borough.
4. Pennsylvania Municipal Code Alliance, Inc., shall at all times when providing services to Newville Borough, maintain valid certifications, as may be required, with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and maintain error and omissions insurance in an amount of at least One Million Dollars.
5. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.
6. Repealer: All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed.
7. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective immediately.

Single family dwelling / one unit.....	\$65
Duplex & Two unit apartment.....	\$110
Apartment houses.....	\$110, plus \$25 for each unit over 2
Hotel.....	\$160, plus \$5 for each unit over 4

Re-inspection Fee same as above unless determined to be a minor violation by the inspector

Code Enforcement Fees (not associated with the periodic RRU Inspection(s), i.e. complaint(s), investigations and similar actions as needed)

Trip charges.....	\$50 each trip per unit
Court Appearance.....	\$75 per hour
Filing Fees.....	Actual Cost to file
Additional Service not covered in this fee schedule.....	\$45 per hour unless negotiated
