

ORDINANCE 2021-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWVILLE, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROHIBITING THE DRINKING OF LIQUOR OR MALT OR BREWED BEVERAGES UPON ANY PUBLIC STREET, PUBLIC MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT, PRIVATE PARKING LOT OPEN TO PUBLIC USE OR PUBLIC PARK, OR IN ANY VEHICLE BEING OPERATED OR PARKED THEREON, AND FIXING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

NOW, THEREFORE BE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby adopted by the Newville Borough Council as follows:

SECTION 1. The following words or phrases, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this section:

“Liquor” or “Malt or Brewed Beverages” and “Container” and “Official Seal” shall mean the same as those words and phrases are defined in the “Liquor Code” of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful, within the Borough of Newville, for any person to drink “liquor” or “malt or brewed beverages” upon any public street, public municipal parking lot, private parking lot open to public use or public park, or in any vehicle being operated or parked thereon.


SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as a legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid provision not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Whenever Borough Council reviews and approves a special event involving alcohol, said approval will be by Resolution and this Ordinance will be suspended for that specifically requested period of the event time as well as its location. At the conclusion of the event involving alcohol this Ordinance will be in full force and effect for the entire Borough of Newville.

SECTION 5. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars nor more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars as civil fines plus reasonable legal fees and the cost of the civil action.


